#### SHORT HISTORY OF THE BARNSLEY TABLE TENNIS LEAGUE

In 1933 organised table tennis began in the district, with the formation of the Barnsley and Wombwell Table Tennis League. Two years later. the Wombwell teams broke away to form their own league, leaving the Barnsley clubs to re-form under the present name.

A glance at the records for those early days reveals one or two names that still occupy a prominent position in the game, such as Frank Walker who has been our Secretary since 1935, and Arthur Walker, our present Chairman, who was a member of the Y.M.C.A. team in 1933. Y.M.C.A. is the only club from the 1933 days still in existence, though Barnsley Boys' Club and Barnsley North End were both founded in 1934.

1936 saw the end of the Wombwell League and several of their clubs joined the Barnsley League which was then extended to two divisions. A year later there were three men's divisions, and for the first time, one Ladies' division. The Barnsley Ladies' teams of 1938-39 and 1939-40 brought honour to the League by winning the Yorkshire Inter-League

Championships both seasons.

Naturally the war affected the game in Barnsley, and there was only limited activity and no league competition between 1940 and 1945. The League was revived in season 1945-46 however, and since then has developed rapidly, so much so, that this season will see 80 teams playing in seven divisions.

The Barnsley Championships were first contested in 1936 with Men's Singles the only event-last season there were 7 events consisting of Men's, Ladies', Youths' and Grade "B" Singles, and Men's, Ladies' and Mixed Doubles. The number of entries for these Championships increases year by year, thereby

proving their great popularity.

No history of the Barnsley Table Tennis League would be complete without paving tribute to its two Presidents. The first was the late Mr. T. D. Cook who rendered invaluable assistance in the early struggles of the League and was responsible for the inauguration of the Closed Championships. In 1945, Mr. J. Railston became President and soon proved himself a worthy successor. It is largely due to his wholehearted co-operation and generosity that the League is in such a sound financial position today.



# Barnsley Table Tennis League

### RULES

- 1. The League shall be called "THE BARNSLEY TABLE TENNIS LEAGUE".
- 2. The annual subscription of 21s. per Club be paid one week before the commencement of the season, by which date any club not having subscribed be withdrawn.
- 3. The League shall be governed by an Executive Committee which shall consist of a President, Chairman, Hon. Secretary, Hon. Treasurer, Hon. Competition Secretary, Hon. Tournamet Secretary, Hon. Match Secretary and five elected members. The Executive Committee to have power to co-opt additional members as and when deemed necessary. All officers shall retire annually, but shall be eligible for re-election. Any vacancy on this Committee caused by resignation during the season shall be filled by the Committee at the meeting at which such resignation is accepted.

The Executive Committee shall have power to appoint from among its members such sub-committees as may be deemed necessary.

- 4. A Quorum for a full Executive Committee meeting shall be five. Five days notice shall be given of E.C. meetings except in the case of extreme urgency.
- 5. The officers shall be elected annually at a General Meeting which shall ordinarily be held at the close of the season.
- 5a. All members of the Clubs affiliated to the Barnsley T.T.L. may attend any Annual Meeting.
- 5b. "Voting" That for purposes of voting at any Annual or General Meeting the Club Secretary or the duly authorised representative of such Club shall be allowed to record a vote for each team which that Club ran in the League during the present or, where such meeting is held in the close season, the past season.
- 6. The Registration fee of two shillings and sixpence per player registered shall be inclusive of player's handbook. Registration not valied unless accompanied by fee. Clubs must register at least three players for each team competing in the League.
- 7. The Rules governing match play shall be those published by the English Table Tennis Association.
- 8. A Club desirous of joining the League must be proposed by a League Club, and nominated at an Executive Committee meeting or by application at a General Meeting.
- 9. All teams shall play one Home match and one Away match with every other team in their division of the League.
- 10. Teams competing in the League Competition shall consist of three players. Each player of one team shall play each player of the opposing team one set. A set to be best of three games. In the third game the players shall change ends when one reaches a score of ten. The match must be played to a finish, and the team winning the majority of sets shall be awarded two points in the competition.

- 11. The Home team has first choice of date and must give its opponents at least seven clear days' notice when informing them of the date fixed. Should the Home team fail in this point then the Away team takes choice and may notify the Home team of the date on which it will present itself. The team being advised of the date offered for match must reply within two days confirming the date.
- 12. In the event of any team not fulfilling an engagement its opponents shall be awarded the match unless another date be mutually agreed upon prior to the date originally fixed. Any team falling to fulfil an engagement, i.e. either the original fixture or the re-arranged match, as the case may be, shall be fined two shillings and sixpence. The score in an awarded match shall be reckoned as 9-nil.
- 13. All matches shall start not later than 7.30 p.m. In the event of non-attendance of a player or players by 8.30 p.m., or such later time as may be agreed upon by the teams' captains prior to the match all his or her games shall be considered lost unless reserves be in attendance. Should a reserve be required to play, he or she shall play on throughout the match. In the event of both teams being one man short the odd set may be claimed by the visiting team.

NOTE—Where possible, any alteration of the time limits for attendance of players should be agreed upon when arranging the date of the match.

- 14. The Secretary of the Home team shall notify the Hon. Competition Secretary of the result of the match within 24 hours following the match date, giving the names of the players and the full scores. These must be forwarded on the official cards and must be certified as correct by the two captains. Any club infringing this rule will be fined 2/6.
- 15. The Unipres for each game shall be agreed upon mutually, and scoring shall be undertaken alternately by a member of the visiting and home teams. In case of dispute as to who shall score, the visiting captain shall name the scorer. Subject to any rearrangement mutually agreed upon, the order of play (A, B, and C being the home team, or in a final being determined by lot), shall be: A v X, B v Y, C v Z, B v X, A v Z, C v Y, B v Z, C v X, A v Y.
- 16. The teams obtaining the greatest number of points shall be declared Division Champions. In the case of a Tie, a deciding match shall be played on a neutral table. The League shall award a cup to the Division Champions, and the club holding a Division Trophy shall provide safe keeping for same, and must return it when requested to do so by the Executive Committee.
- 17. At the end of the season the teams that hold the two bottom places in Division I shall be relegated to Division II, and the two leading teams of Division II shall be promoted to Division I, providing that the clubs from which the teams are entered apply for and are granted affiliation during the proper period prior to the following season. In all cases the constitution of the Division shall be decided by the Executive Committee. If extra divisions are necessary promotion and relegation to higher and lower divisions respectively to apply as in Division I and II.
- 18. Players in all teams must wear rubber plimsols when playing in matches.
- 19. The absence or inability of regular players shall not be deemed a sufficient reason for the postponement of a match. In such cases reserves must be played.

20. A player registered for an 'A', 'B', 'C', 'D', Ladies or Youths team of any particular club, is limited to a total of five matches in one season, with any senior team or teams (e.g. a 'B' team player may play in five matches for the 'A' team, or in three for the 'A' team and two for the 1st team). No player shall, however, he eligible to play for more than one team in the same Division.

21. No player shall be eligible to play in a League game until he has been registered three clear days, and each player shall he has been registered three clear days, and each player shall be a bona-fide member of the Club for which he or she may be registered. No player may be registered for more than one club at a time. If a player desires to transfer from one club to another he shall make personal application to the Executive Committee and the Executive Committee's decision shall be final. A transfer fee of two shillings and sixpence per player shall be payable at the discretion of the Executive Committee, No transfers or registrations shall be allowed after the second Saturday in February. The league shall not register any player who is a registered player of another league. who is a registered player of another league.

22. Any club playing an ineligible player shall be fined not less than two shillings and sixpence, and the ineligible player's games shall be reckoned as lost 2-nil.

23. In the event of a team retiring from the League for any reason during the season, no money shall be refunded, and all the matches played by that team shall be declared void.

24. Fines shall be paid within one month, after which clubs owing five shillings or more in fines shall be suspended from playing in all matches until the full amount be paid.

25. All protests with claims shall be in writing, and shall be lodged with the League Secretary within seven days after the match. The club protesting must also send a copy of the claim and protest to the opponents concerned.

26. Each club must provide suitable accommodation and lighting facilties for matches to the satisfaction of the

Executive Committee.

27. The make of the ball to be used in all matches shall be selected from the E.T.T.A. list by the Annual General Meeting and be named in the handbook. Balls for this season to be one of the following: Barna 2c and 3c, Villa 2x and 3x, Halex

28. The composition of the Divisions of the League Competition shall be decided by the Executive Committee after the closing

date for application for membership.

29. The Hon. Treasurer shall present accounts for the pre-ceding year at the Annual General Meeting, such accounts to be audited by two auditors appointed from among the members at the previous Annual General Meeting. The auditors shall retire annually, but shall be eligible for re-election.

30. Nominations for election of officers shall be sent in writing to the Hon. Secretary not later than April 1st each year. The complete list of nominations received shall be sent out to all

clubs two weeks before the Annual General Meeting.

31. In the event of any question arising not provided for in the foregoing rules such question shall be referred to the Executive Committee and the decision of that Committee shall

be final and binding.

32. No amendment to or alteration of these Rules shall be made except at an Annual General Meeting, when fourteen days' notice shall be given, or by vote of a Special General Meeting which may be called at any time on the requisition of one half of the number of clubs in the League, in which case seven clear days' notice shall be given, or unless all clubs being represented at a General Meeting unanimously agree to such alteration.

#### TOURNAMENTS

#### Barnsley "Closed" Championships

- (1) The events shall consist of Ladies' Men's, Youths' and Grade 'B' Singles and Ladies', Men's and Mixed Doubles.
- (2) All members of Clubs affiliated to the Barnsley T.T.L. shall be eligible to enter the tournament which will be organised in accordance with E.T.T.A. and Y.T.T.A. Rules.
- (3) The Grade 'B' Singles shall be open to all members other than Div. I players and past winners of a Barnsley "Closed" Championship in any of the following events:—Men's and Grade 'B' Singles.
- (4) Youths' Singles shall be open to all Junior Members of affiliated Clubs who have not attained the age of 18 years on the 1st October in the same season.
- (5) Preliminary rounds, up to and including the semi-finals, shall be played at various selected Club Rooms and the finals on a night agreed by the Executive Committee who shall select the venue.
- (6) Entry fees for all events shall be fixed by the Executive Committee.
- (7) Admission fees and right of entry to be agreed by the Executive Committee.
- (8) Any other action in relation to the championships not covered by the foregoing rules shall be decided by the Executive Committee.

#### KNOCK-OUT COMPETITIONS

- (1) This shall be a team event.
- (2) The number of players constituting a team and type of play shall be decided by the Annual General Meeting.
- (3) Each round shall be drawn separately, the team drawn first having choice of venue up to and including the semi-finals. The final must be played on a neutral table.
- (4) The home team must offer their opponents, in writing, two dates at least seven days before the intention to play the match.
- (5) The Executive Committee shall fix closing dates for each round.
- (6) Entry fees shall be fixed by the Executive Committee and must accompany all entry forms, otherwise the entry will be ignored.
- (7) The winning team captain must forward the result, on the score card provided, to the Hon. Competition Secretary within 24 hours of the match being played.
- (8) All matters not covered by the foregoing rules shall be dealt with by the Executive Committee.

#### OTHER TOURNAMENTS

Various other tournaments and competitions may be organised id directed by the Annual General Meeting or deemed to be necessary by the Executive Committee.

### New Service Rule

In the delivery of the service the free hand of any two handed player shall be open flat, with the fingers straight and together, thumb free, and the ball resting on the palm without being cupped or pinched in any way by the fingers. The ball shall be released by the free hand, by lifting upwards.

The object of the rule is to place responsibility on the server of proving that he is not using finger spin in service; in other words that any spin on his service comes from his racket.

The only way to prove this is to observe the rule in all particulars:—

Hand open. Thumb free. Hand flat. Ball resting on palm. Fingers straight. Ball not cupped or pinched by the fingers. Fingers together. Ball released by raising the hand.

PLAYERS! Learn this rule and observe it. UMPIRES! See that players observe the rule




