BARNSELY TABLE TENNIS LEAGUE RULES

1. The League shall be called "THE BARNSELY TABLE TENNIS LEAGUE". Objects—To promote and control the game in Barnsley within the framework of the E.T.T.A. and to apply all income of the League solely to these objects.

2. The annual subscription of 30/- per Club shall be paid one week before the commencement of the season, by which date any club not having subscribed be withdrawn. Each club shall also deposit 20/- with the League prior to the commencement of the playing season, as evidence of good faith and assurance of fulfilment of all fixtures. 10/- shall be forfeited for each team that withdraws from the League before the end of the season.

2a. The accounts shall be made up as at 31st March each year.

3. The League shall be governed by an Executive Committee which shall consist of a President, Chairman, Hon. Secretary, Hon. Treasurer, Hon. Competition Secretary, Hon. Tournament Secretary, Hon. Match Secretary, Hon. Minute Secretary, Hon. Social Secretary and five elected members. The Executive Committee to have power to co-opt additional members as and when deemed necessary. All officers shall retire annually, but shall be eligible for re-election. In no circumstances shall any one Club provide more than four of the Officials and Executive Committee, excluding the Chairman. In the event of more being elected, priority to be given to the Officials. Any vacancy on this Committee caused by resignation during the season shall be filled by the Committee at the meeting at which such resignation is accepted.

The Executive Committee shall have power to appoint from among its members such sub-committees as may be deemed necessary.

4. A Quorum for a full Executive Committee meeting shall be five. Five days notice shall be given of E.C. meetings except in the case of extreme urgency.

5. The officers shall be elected annually at a General Meeting which shall ordinarily be held at the close of the season.

5a. All members of the Clubs affiliated to the Barnsley T.T.L. may attend any Annual or Council Meeting.

5b. "Voting". For purposes of voting at any Annual General Meeting each club shall be allowed one vote only.

6. The Registration fee of three shillings per player registered shall be inclusive of player's handbook. Registration not valid unless accompanied by fee. Clubs must register at least three players for each team competing in the League. The Executive Committee shall have the power to reject any player who has been registered in a division below his status.

7. The Rules governing match play shall be those published by the English Table Tennis Association.

8. A Club desirous of joining the League must be proposed by a League Club, and nominated at an Executive Committee meeting or by application at a General Meeting.

9. All teams shall play one Home match and one Away match with every other team in their division of the League.

10. Teams competing in the League Competition shall consist of three players. Each player of one team shall play each player of the opposing team one set, after which one doubles set shall be played, any two of the three players constituting the doubles pair. A set to be best of three games. In the third game the players shall change ends when one reaches a score of ten. The match must be played to a finish, and teams shall be awarded two points for a win, and one point for a draw.

11. All teams must state on their League entry form their fixed home match night. Matches must be played on the dates specified in the fixtures, and no notification by home or visiting team is necessary, except as provided for in Rule 12. Any club wishing to change their home match night must first apply to the Executive Committee for permission.

12. In the event of any team not fulfilling an engagement its opponents shall be awarded the match as the date of a match may only be re-arranged with the consent of the Hon. Comp. Secretary and in this case not less than three days' notice shall be given to the opposing team's secretary and to the Hon. Comp. Secretary, together with the re-arranged date which must be within 14 days of the original date. Any team failing to fulfil an engagement, i.e. either the original fixture or the re-arranged match, as the case may be, shall be fined five shillings. The score in an awarded match shall be reckoned as 10-0. In the event of two players failing to turn up in a match, the club shall be fined 2s.6d.

13. All matches shall start not later than 7.30 p.m. In the event of non-attendance of a player or players by 8.30 p.m., or such later time as may be agreed upon by the teams' captains prior to the match all his or her games shall be considered lost unless reserves be in attendance. Should a reserve be required to play, he or she shall play on throughout the match. In the event of both teams being one man short the odd set may be claimed by the visiting team.

14. The Secretary of the Home team shall notify the Hon. Competition Secretary of the result of the match within 24 hours following the match date, giving the names and initials of the players and the full scores written in Block letters and in ink. These must be forwarded on the official cards and must be certified as correct by the two captains. Any club infringing this rule will be fined 2/6d.

15. The Umpires for each game shall be agreed upon mutually, and scoring shall be undertaken alternately by a member of the visiting and home teams. In case of dispute as to who shall score, the visiting captain shall name the scorer. Subject to any rearrangement mutually agreed upon, the order of play (A, B, and C being the home team, or in a final being determined by lot), shall be :- A v X, B v Y, C v Z, B v X, A v Z, C v Y, B v Z, C v X, A v Y, one doubles. The captains shall exchange their order of play simultaneously, except for the doubles pairings, which shall be stated after the last singles set has been played.

16. The teams obtaining the greatest number of points shall be declared Division Champions. In the case of a Tie, a deciding match shall be played on a neutral table. In all other cases where teams finish level on points their position in the League shall be determined by the team having the best sets average. The League shall award a cup to the Division Champions, and the Club holding a Division Trophy shall provide safe keeping for same and must return it when requested to do so by the Executive Committee.

17. At the end of the season the teams that hold the two bottom places in Division I shall be relegated to Division II, and the two leading teams of Division II shall be promoted to Division I, providing that the clubs from which the teams are entered apply for and are granted affiliation during the proper period prior to the following season. If extra divisions are necessary promotion and relegation to higher and lower divisions respectively to apply as in Division I and II.

18. Players in all teams must wear rubber plimsols when playing in matches.

19. The absence or non-availability of regular players shall not be deemed a sufficient reason for the postponement of a match. In such cases reserves must be played.

20. Players registered for a team other than the 1st team of a club are allowed a total of 5 appearances in one season with any senior team or teams.

Should reserve players make a sixth appearance in a senior team, they automatically become members of that team, and then may not play for any other team of that club during the same season. A re-registration fee of 1/6d. per player will be payable in such cases. No player shall, however, be eligible to play for more than one team in the same division, or play in a lower division than the one for which registered.


21. No player shall be eligible to play in a League game until he has been registered three clear days, and each player shall be a bona-fide member of the Club for which he or she may be registered. No player may be registered for more than one club at a time. If a player desires to transfer from one club to another he shall make written application to the Hon. Secretary and send a copy of the application to his club secretary who shall send written comment on the application to the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee's decision on the application shall be final. A transfer fee of two shillings and sixpence per player shall be payable. No transfers or registrations shall be allowed after the second Saturday in February. In the case of a player wishing to transfer in the close season, written notification must be given to his or her club secretary. The league shall not register any player who is a registered player of another league, except at the discretion of the Executive Committee.

22. Any club playing an ineligible player shall be fined not less than two shillings and sixpence, and the ineligible player's sets shall be reckoned as lost.

23. The League has first claim upon the services of any registered player for any of its representative matches.

23a. The Barnsley League Badge shall be awarded to players who have represented the League in three E.T.T.A. or Inter-League matches.

24. In the event of a team retiring from the League for any reason during the season, no money shall be refunded, and all the matches played by that team shall be declared void. Any club withdrawing from the League shall lose all voting powers. Individual registrations to remain valid to the end of the season at the discretion of the Executive Committee.

25. Fines shall be paid within one month, after which clubs owing five shillings or more in fines shall be suspended from playing in all matches until the full amount be paid.

26. All protests with claims shall be in writing, and shall be lodged with the League Secretary within seven days after the match. The club protesting must also send a copy of the claim and protest to the opponents concerned.

27. Each club must provide suitable accommodation and lighting facilities for matches to the satisfaction of the Executive Committee.

28. The make of the ball to be used in all matches shall be selected from the E.T.T.A. list by the Annual General Meeting and be named in the handbook. Balls for this season to be one of the following: Barna 2c and 3c, Villa 2x and 3x, Halex 2s and 3s.

29. The composition of the Divisions of the League Competition shall be decided by the Executive Committee after the closing date for application for membership.

30. The Hon. Treasurer shall present accounts for the preceding year at the Annual General Meeting, such accounts to be audited by two auditors appointed from among the members at the previous Annual General Meeting. The auditors shall retire annually, but shall be eligible for re-election.

31. Nominations for election of Officers and any proposed alteration to rules shall be sent to the Hon. Secretary on a form to be provided by the League and despatched to clubs by 23rd March. This form to be returned not later than 1st April each year. The list of nominations received together with a copy of the Agenda and Statement of Accounts shall be sent out to all clubs 14 days before the Annual General Meeting.

32. Any club failing to be represented at a Council Meeting or General Meeting shall be fined 5/-.

33. In the event of any question arising not provided for in the foregoing rules or the rules governing the E.T.T.A. or Y.T.T.A. such question shall be referred to the Executive Committee and the decision of that Committee shall be final and binding.

34. No amendment to or alteration of these Rules shall be made except at an Annual General Meeting, when fourteen days' notice shall be given, or by vote of a Special General Meeting which may be called at any time on the requisition of one half of the number of clubs in the League, in which case seven clear days' notice shall be given, or unless all clubs being represented at a General Meeting unanimously agree to such alteration.

TOURNAMENTS

Barnsley "Closed" Championships

(1) The events shall consist of Ladies' Men's, Youths' and Grade 'B' Singles and Ladies', Men's and Mixed Doubles. There shall be no seeding in any of the events.

(2) All members of Clubs affiliated to the Barnsley T.T.L. shall be eligible to enter the tournament which will be organised in accordance with E.T.T.A. and Y.T.T.A. Rules.

(3) The Grade 'B' Singles shall be open to all members other than Div. 1 players and past winners of a Barnsley "Closed" Championship in any of the following events:—Men's and Grade 'B' Singles. The Executive Committee reserve the right to refuse entries to the Grade 'B' or 'C' Singles Championships from any player deemed to be of too high a standard for these events.

(4) Youths' Singles shall be open to all Junior Members of affiliated Clubs who have not attained the age of 18 years on the 1st October in the same season.

(5) Preliminary rounds, up to and including the semi-finals, shall be played at various selected Club Rooms and the finals on a night agreed by the Executive Committee who shall select the venue.

(6) Entry fees for all events shall be fixed by the Executive Committee.

(7) Admission fees and right of entry to be agreed by the Executive Committee.

(8) Any other action in relation to the championships not covered by the foregoing rules shall be decided by the Executive Committee.

KNOCK-OUT COMPETITIONS

(1) This shall be a team event. Only players registered with the B.T.T.L. shall be eligible to play.

(2) The number of players constituting a team and type of play shall be decided by the Annual General Meeting.

(3) The complete draw shall be made at the outset, when each round shall be separately drawn, using numerals for team identification in the second and subsequent rounds. The final must be played on a neutral table. The captains shall exchange their order of play simultaneously, before play begins.

(4) The home team must offer their opponents, in writing, two dates at least seven days before the intention to play the match.

(5) The Executive Committee shall fix closing dates for each round.

(6) Entry fees shall be fixed by the Executive Committee and must accompany all entry forms, otherwise the entry will be ignored.

(7) The winning team captain must forward the result, on the score card provided, to the Hon. Competition Secretary within 24 hours of the match being played.

(8) All matters not covered by the foregoing rules shall be dealt with by the Executive Committee.

OTHER COMPETITIONS

Various other tournaments and competitions may be organised if directed by the Annual General Meeting or deemed to be necessary by the Executive Committee.


